# Who We Are

We provide education, financial, employment, and income support coaching and operate a community food pantry.

## What You Will Do

As the Food Pantry Associate, you will help staff the food pantry, organize inventory, stocking, and ordering for pantry items, respond to pantry-related emails and calls from the community, manage volunteers, support special events, document standard operating procedures for the pantry, and enroll pantry members.

### When You Serve with Us

- Earn a \$13,500 stipend (\$15/hour) payable by bimonthly direct deposit.
- Earn an additional \$3,447 education benefit to pay down qualifying student loan debt or to continue your education.
- Receive ongoing coaching, mentorship, and professional development.

# What Your Work Environment Will Be

An 11-month position where you will typically serve 20 hours a week, generally between Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., with occasional evenings and weekends. An exact schedule will be determined upon selection. You will report in person at our office and will be required to travel locally for meetings and community events.

- Have lived experience or an interest in working with a diverse group of people.
- Identify as any generation but are at least 17 years old.
- Possess unexpired proof of status as a US citizen or permanent resident.
